

Session Plan: Introduction to My Health Record

Session overview:

This session will introduce learners to My Health Record. My Health Record is an online platform allowing healthcare professionals to share information with each other as well as the patient, to help give a clearer and more complete picture of a person's health to aid in their treatment. This session will give learners an overview of the platform, along with the opportunity to access and use My Health Record.

Learning objectives:

To increase learners' knowledge and confidence in using My Health Record and be able to make an informed decision about whether it is something they would like to access for themselves.

Suggested session length:

90 minutes

Introduction	10 mins	Welcome everyone to the session and ask learners to complete the CaptureIT Sign in form. Discuss the learning objectives and have a group discussion: Question suggestion: "How much do you know about My Health Record?" Show the video, "About My Health Record" (1.20 mins)	This will show how much learners can tell you about My Health Record. It will help you make sure you are aiming your session at the right level. Tour the My Health Record website	30 mins	Using the link in the resource column, tour the Digital Health website to show the learners more information about My Health record. Show the video, "Introduction to the Record Homepage" (2.41 mins). You may wish to pause the video at times to show the key areas and to discuss them. • Alerts and notifications • Health snapshot	After the video, ask questions about the areas that learners can see in a record to check their understanding. Accessing My Health Record	10 mins	Discuss with learners the way to access a My Health Record and how to link this to your MyGov account. Show the video, "Linking My Health Record to myGov". (3.37mins) Mention where the information contained in My Health Record comes from.	Quick questions at the end such as "so what information will MyGov ask of you when you try to link your My Health Record?" or "how would you access your My Health Record if you can't answer the security questions?" will show understanding. Break	10 mins	Give learners a chance to have some informal chat time to talk about what you have just shown them		
Practical activity to summarize	20 mins	Ask learners to complete the Online learning module - for My Health Record Home Page. Some video content may be repeated and it contains quiz questions. Session review and wrap up	10 mins	Group discussion. Ask open questions around My Health Record and how it works, the different sections and what information you might find on there. Revisit Learning objectives and ensure everyone agrees that they've been met.	Learners should be able to answer questions fully based on what they've seen at this session	Seek feedback on the session.
