

# Where is AI now?

Video clips can be a great tool to assist learners in gaining a deeper understanding of content. It can assist learners in visualising a concept, an event or person

## **Provide a mission.**

How can we make sure learners actively watch? Provide a mission before playing the video. Ask the learners to look out for the key takeaways.

### **Key takeaways**

Understand where AI is currently being used.

Understand some basic terms.

## **Pause to ponder**

Give learners time to reflect by pausing the clip. Watch a few minutes and then pause the video to ask learners to discuss what they just saw, write down reflections, or answer a question you provide.

Pausing allows students time to process what they're viewing.
