



Password Tips and Activity

Aim:

To assist learners to develop robust and easy to recall passwords for use in their online activities.

How to:

- Print out the four page Activity handout that follows this instruction sheet.
- Explain why a password is important and when they may be used.
- Explain some key points on how to create stronger passwords.
- Provide time for the learners to practise creating a password using the Activity handout.
- Remind learners they should not share their passwords with anyone as they are private.

Outcome:

Learners will create pretend passwords using a variety of methods, increasing their confidence and gaining a deeper understanding of their importance.

1 Holiday places

Think of your favourite holiday.
Write the name of the place and then add numbers and a symbol.
Example:
Gold Coast + 2013 + !
Could be written as GoldCoast2013!
Your turn to try this:

2 Favourite foods

Think of your favourite foods.
Pick 3 of them and join them together to create a silly word.
Example
Banana + cake + pie
could be written as Bananacakepie
Your turn to try this.

3 Colours

Pick a colour that	ou like or makes v	vou feel happy.
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Then, add some numbers and a symbol to it.

Example

Red + 87 + #

could be written as Red87#
