

Session Plan: Checking fuel prices online

Delivery mode:

Face to face

Session overview:

This session will focus on how learners can check fuel prices online. It includes an interactive online activity.

Learning objectives:

At the end of this session, learners will be able to:

- Identify credible fuel comparison websites/apps
- Use credible fuel comparison websites and/or apps to check fuel prices

Suggested session length:

This session should run for approximately 60 minutes. The facilitator to schedule breaks as required.

Facilitator tip:

- Ahead of the fuel bingo online activity, look up the top 3 cheapest fuel prices.

Introduction & welcome	10 mins	Facilitator to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce themselves • Ask learners to introduce themselves Icebreaker: Put your hand up if. Ask learners to put up their hand if they do what the sentence says. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put your hand up if: You drive around to find the cheapest fuel • Put your hand up if: You have your favourite petrol stations and don't go anywhere else • Put your hand up if: You drive outside of your suburb because you think it will have cheaper fuel 	All learners engage	Refreshments Laptop / PC Notepad / Pens Whiteboard / marker pens Projector Be Connected article: How to save money on petrol

Topic	Timing	Activity	Assessment	Resources
		<p>Facilitator to link the icebreaker back to the topic. Refer to the Be Connected article: How to save money on petrol.</p> <p>Facilitator shares a quick overview on what will be covered today.</p>		
Discussion	15 mins	<p>Facilitator to discuss the main points of the Be Connected article: How to save money on petrol.</p> <p>In the discussion, include a step-by-step guide on how to use the fuel app or navigate the website.</p> <p>Tip: Remind learners to only download apps from official app stores.</p> <p>Ask learners if they have any questions.</p>	Learners engage in the discussion.	Be Connected article: How to save money on petrol
Break	5 mins	Encourage learners to have a break, stretch their legs and have a drink if needed.

Online activity: Fuel bingo	20 mins	<p>Play fuel bingo! The online activity can be done as a group or individually. Learners need to find the top 3 cheapest petrol stations in your community.</p> <p>Facilitator to support learners with accessing or downloading the app or website.</p>	Learners engage at their own pace.	<p>Learners phones or other device Laptop/PC Projector</p> <p>Be Connected article: How to save money on petrol</p>
Reflection and close	10 mins	<p>Recap the key points.</p> <p>Ask the learners if they have any questions.</p> <p>Before wrapping up your session, share a safety tip with your learners. Ask them: When is the best time to use price comparison apps for petrol? Answer: Before you start driving only. Do not use apps when you are driving your car.</p>	<p>All learners participate</p> <p>Asking questions will demonstrate their understanding of the material.</p>
