

## **Session Plan: Learn Android icons**

### **Delivery mode:**

Face to face or virtual delivery

### **Session overview:**

This session will focus on identifying and understanding the meanings of different Android icons.

### **Learning objectives:**

At the end of this session, learners will be able to:

- Identify Android icons
- Understand some common Android icons

### **Suggested session length:**

This session should run for approximately 85 minutes with a 10 minute break. The facilitator to schedule additional breaks as required.

### **Prior knowledge**

This session is for learners who are able to complete basic tasks on their smart phone like tapping and swiping.

### Facilitator tip:

- Set up a projector ahead of time
- Prepare the icon treasure hunt game ahead of the session. Select 5 icons that may not be familiar to your community.
- Consider printing the [Android icon glossary](#) as a supporting resource for your learners in the discussion

Introduction & welcome	15 mins	Facilitator to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Introduce themselves</li> <li>• Learners to introduce themselves</li> </ul> Icebreaker discussion: Do you know the Android icon? Project the <a href="#">Android icon glossary</a> on a big screen. This will help you with understanding your learners' knowledge of Android icons. 		<p>Ask your learners questions to prompt a brief discussion. Here are some questions to get you started:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Which icons do you recognise? What does the icon mean?</li> <li>• Which icons are you unsure about?</li> <li>• What do you do if you want to learn more about an icon you don't know?</li> </ul> <p>Introduce the session.</p>		
Discussion	30 mins	<p>Project the <a href="#">Android icon glossary</a> on a big screen. If you have printed the glossary, prompt your learners to follow along.</p> <p>Facilitator to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify the icons</li> <li>• Define what it is used for</li> <li>• Outline where the icon could be found</li> </ul> <p>Prompt your learners to follow and identify the icons on their own devices.</p>	<p>Learners engage in the discussion.</p> <p>Print outs of the Be Connected article: <a href="#">Which Android icon is that?</a></p>	<p>Be Connected article: <a href="#">Which Android icon is that?</a></p>

		Learners may need extra support when finding the icons on their devices.		
<b>Break</b>	10 mins	<p>Take a break.</p> <p>Prompt your learners to get a drink, stretch their legs or use the bathroom.</p>		
Online activity: Icon treasure hunt game	20 mins	<p>Game: Icon treasure hunt!</p> <p>On a big screen, project your icon treasure hunt game.</p> <p>Learners can play the game in pairs or individually. Ask your learners to look for the icon on their devices and to call out “found!” when they find it.</p> <p>Make sure that all your learners find the icon before moving to the next round.</p> <p>Your learners may need extra support in this game</p>	Learners engage as a group or individually.	Laptop/PC Projector Be Connected article: <a href="#">Which Android icon is that?</a>
