

Session Plan: Get to know your Android smart phone

Delivery mode:

Face to face

Session overview:

This session will introduce Android smart phones and their different features to learners.

Learning objectives:

At the end of this session, learners will be able to:

- Identify different features of their Android smart phones
- Learn some functions of their Android smart phones

Suggested session length:

This session should run for approximately 70 minutes. The facilitator to schedule breaks as required.

- Ahead of the session, ask your learner to make sure their devices are charged.

Introduction & welcome	10 mins	Facilitator to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce themselves • Learners to introduce themselves Icebreaker: Get to know your learners and what their learning goals are. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What are you most excited to do on your smart phone? • What is one thing you want to learn about using an Android? • Have you used a smart phone before? Discussion	20 mins	On a big screen project the Android phone: Interactive guide and explore the different Android features together. Facilitator to explain each feature and how it works.	Learners engage in the discussion.	Be Connected course: All about Android phone

Break	5 mins	Encourage your learners to stretch their legs and have a drink.		
Online activity: Android activity competition	20 mins	<p>Android activity competition. Facilitator to remove the guide from the screen, it's time to put everything to the test!</p> <p>Learners need to complete these following tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Go to the home screen and take a photo using the front camera ● Go to the home screen and swipe up to see more apps ● Turn the volume up and down ● Lock and unlock the phone <p>Tip: Don't touch your learners device! Guide them and motivate them to do it themselves. It's also important to remember that everyone learns at their own pace.</p>	Learners engage as a group or individually.
